Presenter: Tadeusz Majewski

Topic: Chopin and the Dances of Poland

Description: Exploration of Chopin Polonaises and Mazurkas in the context of their ethnic origins. A musical journey from his childhood in the Polish countryside near Warsaw, to the salons of Parisian aristocracy. An in-depth look at the idiomatic nature of the folk dances and their influence on Chopin's creative genius.

Tadeusz Majewski was born in Krakow, Poland. He began his study of the piano with Janina Garscia-Gressel and later graduated from the Chopin Conservatoire under the supervision of Maria Szmyd-Dormus. In 1977, he won the top award at the annual Chopin Society competition in Warsaw. However, it was the prize in the 1984 First New York Chopin Competition which provided greater recognition as a Chopin interpreter. In 1997, Majewski was honored with a McKnight Fellowship Grant which led to his New York City debut recital.

Mentoring from Andras Schiff, Murray Perahia, Richard Goode and, above all, the unforgettable inspiration of Mieczyslaw Horszowski were guideposts along the path of Majewski's growth as a musician. Chopin has been an essential companion in all of his artistic endeavors, from his early studies at the esteemed Chopin Conservatoire and Academy of Music in Krakow, to the formation and ongoing artistic leadership of the Chopin Society of Minnesota.
